

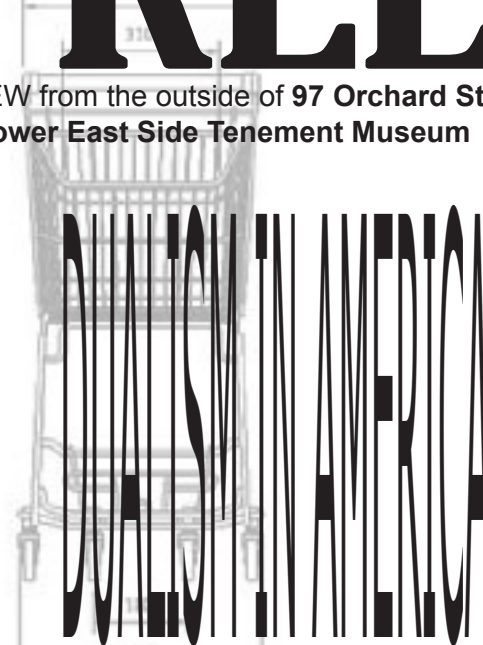

Artist **Wendy W. Fok** contrasts the internationally-held conception of the “American Dream” with the harsh realities new immigrants are often confronted with once here. Fok explores this contradiction through a juxtaposition of common American consumer products that represent the United States to the outside world, with photographs taken by immigrants of their day-to-day lives. The exhibition will tie the past hopes of previous immigration streams with today’s new immigrants and focus on their shared misconceptions of a land where ‘the streets are paved with gold’ or, perhaps, bottles of designer water.
